- Approval of Minutes September 24, 2018
   Mayor DiNatale of Fitchburg moved to approve the minutes from January 23, 2019. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
- FY2019 Financial Update
   James informed the Committee as of February 2019 MART has a \$1.1 million deficit. MART is trending to end the year with a deficit of \$400,000. The key drivers to reducing the deficit are the close of the TLT legal fees, restructure of Athol services and increase in fees for several services. MART also cut overtime, restructured of the ticket agency hours and decreased the telephone rates. The deficit will not impact MART's ability to perform services.
- Budget FY2020
   James stated if the \$90.5 million budget passes MART will receive about \$577,000 more in funding. He then went over Budget Comparison document (attached).

   Ken Troup of Bolton moved to recommend the revised FY2020 budget as presented by the Administrator, to the MART Advisory Board. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
- Open Items
   Bruno updated the Committee on the Ayer Commuter Rail Parking Facility. Bruno informed the Board that the State doesn't want MART to borrow the additional \$1 million needed for the project. The State is looking into capital funds to help finance the \$1 million.
